Anonymous/Privacy Verification

- It does seem that there should be some industry consistency with how privacy verification should be handled in terms of showing end user that the call is verified even though there is a privacy indication.
- Because there are some use cases that are valid uses of privacy where the caller does want the call to be answered, but has legitimate reasons for hiding the caller telephone number, such as shelter or whistleblower cases, we think we should have a MUST verify.
- This is above and beyond the already agreed procedure of using verification for traceback and potentially for CVT applications.
